

**MINUTES OF CUBY PARISH MEETING HELD IN CUBY CHURCH HALL
AT 7.30PM ON THURSDAY 5th DECEMBER 2019**

1. Present: Mr D Attwater (chairman), Mr P Michell (vice chairman), Mr R Heywood (clerk), Mrs R Heywood, Mr J Merrick, Mr D Michell.
Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Bob Egerton, Mrs P Bearman, Mrs C Michell and Mrs D Richards.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting held on Thursday 5th September 2019 were not read, since they had been distributed by email. After the date had been corrected in item 9, they were adopted and signed as a true record of proceedings.
3. Matters arising from the minutes. Mr Attwater had attended the last meeting of the Burial Board in accordance with the procedure agreed at the meeting on 5th September.
4. Chairman's Update. Mr Attwater gave an overview of the Parish Governance Review. The panel ah recommended that Cuby should be merged with Tregony in a new parish to be represented by ten unwarded councillors. Mr Attwater understood that no one wished to challenge this proposal. The panel's recommendations would be put to Cornwall Council on 10th December 2019, and a public consultation would follow up to 10th March 2020. He intended to comment that the new parish should be in the Roseland ward rather than in Probus as at present, since historically Tregony and Cuby had been aligned with the Roseland. Mr P Michell pointed out that Cuby's precept would rise and Tregony's fall as a result of a merger. It was also noted that two thirds of the wind turbine community fund should be allocated to the new parish. Cornwall Council had scheduled to make an order for the new arrangements in September 2020, but there was no date yet set for implementation.
5. Financial report. The financial report was approved and accepted as a true record of the accounts as at 5th December 2019.
6. Precept 2020/2021. Mr P Michell proposed and Mrs Heywood seconded that the Precept be set at £2000, the same level as in the previous year. This was carried unanimously.
7. Any other business. Mention was made of the pot holes on Goviley road, and Mr Attwater advised that they should be reported on Cornwall Council website.
8. Date of next meeting. was set for Thursday 4th April 2019 at 7.30pm subject to the chairman's variation. Mr Attwater thanked people for attending and closed the meeting at 8.20pm.
