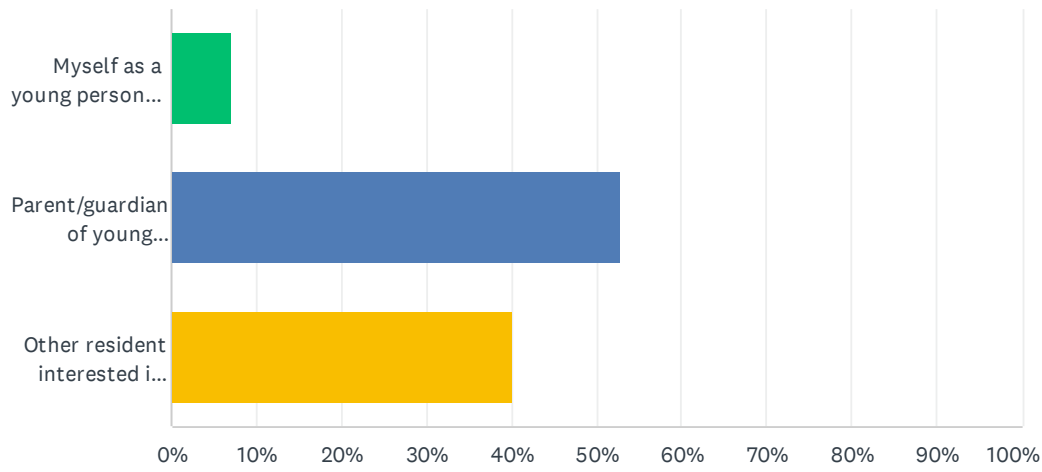


Q1 For whom are you completing this survey?

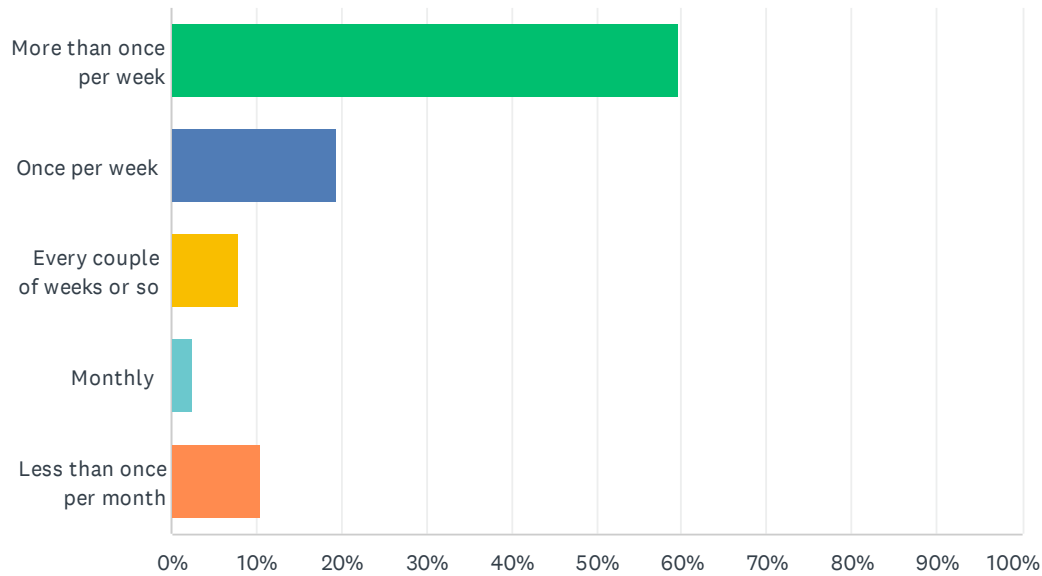

Q2 How often do you or your children engage in sport or recreational facilities outside the village?

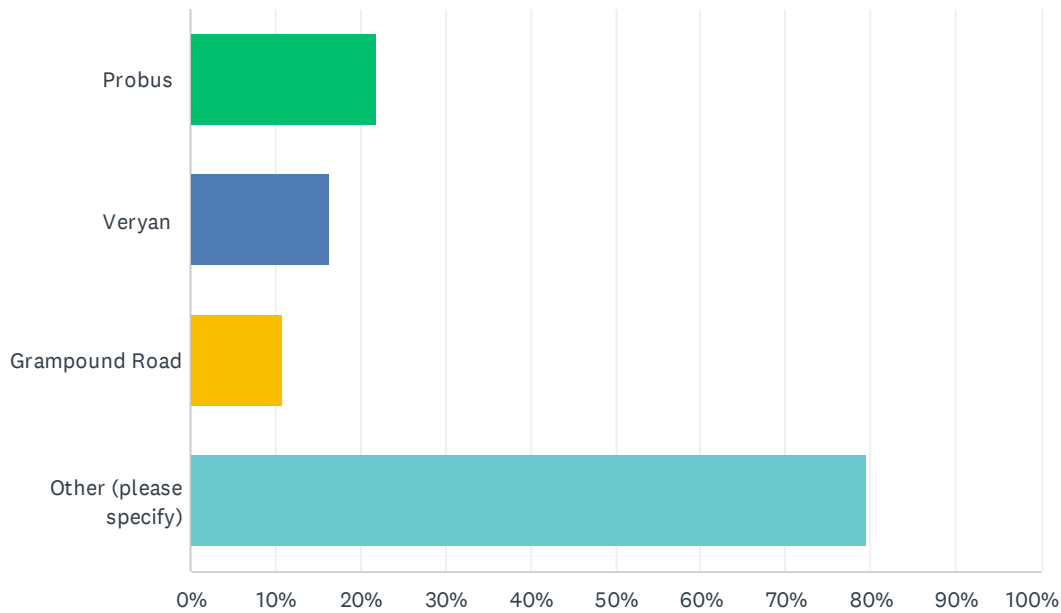

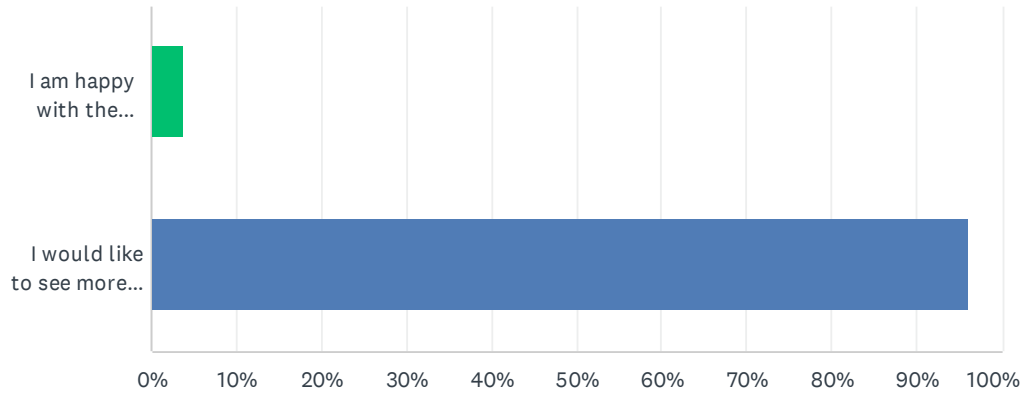

Q4 Are you content with the what you currently do for sport or recreation, or would you like to see more facilities within Tregony with Cuby?

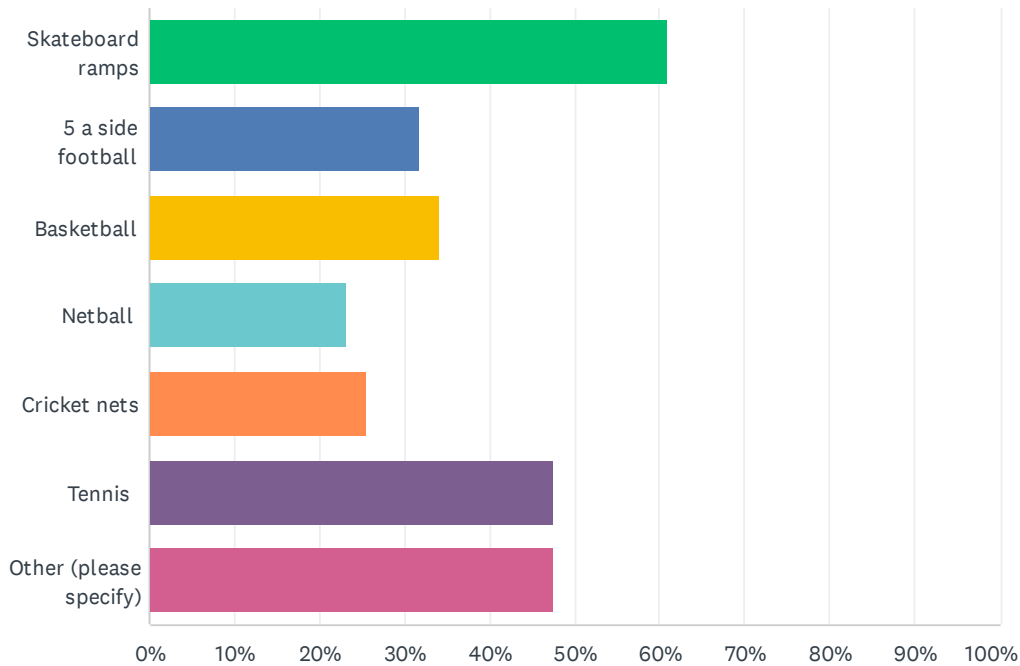

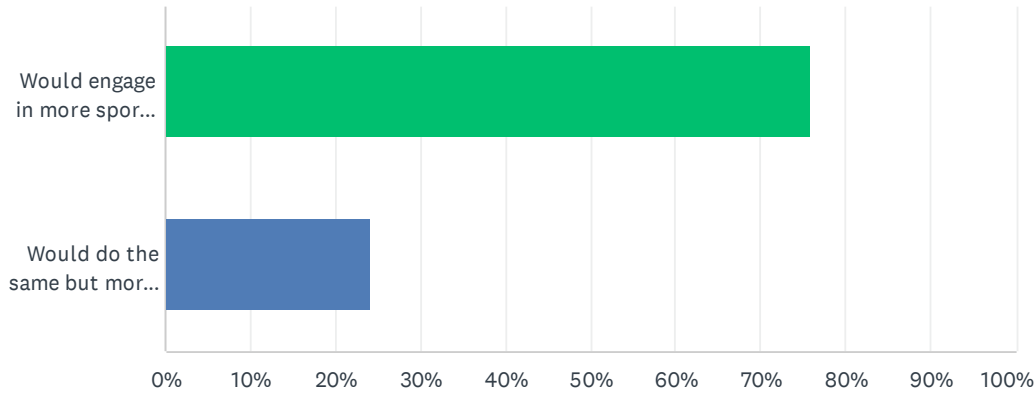

Q6 If more facilities were available in the parish, do you think that you or your children would engage in more sport and recreation, or just find it more convenient than what you currently do?

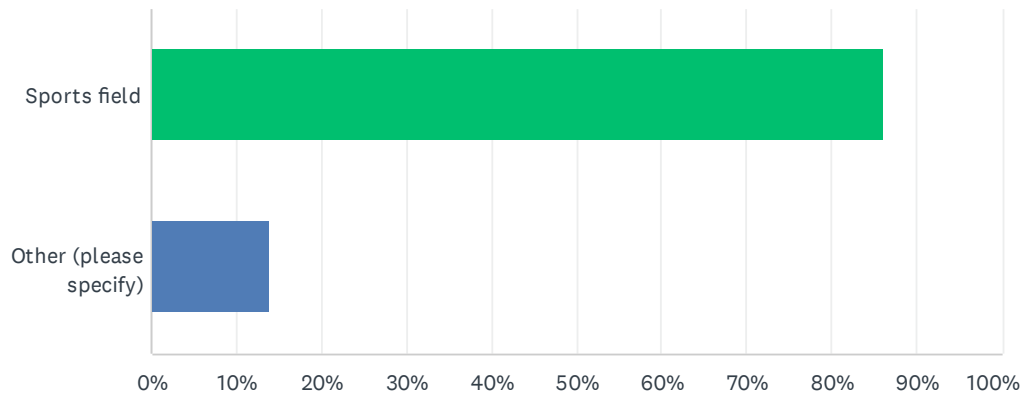

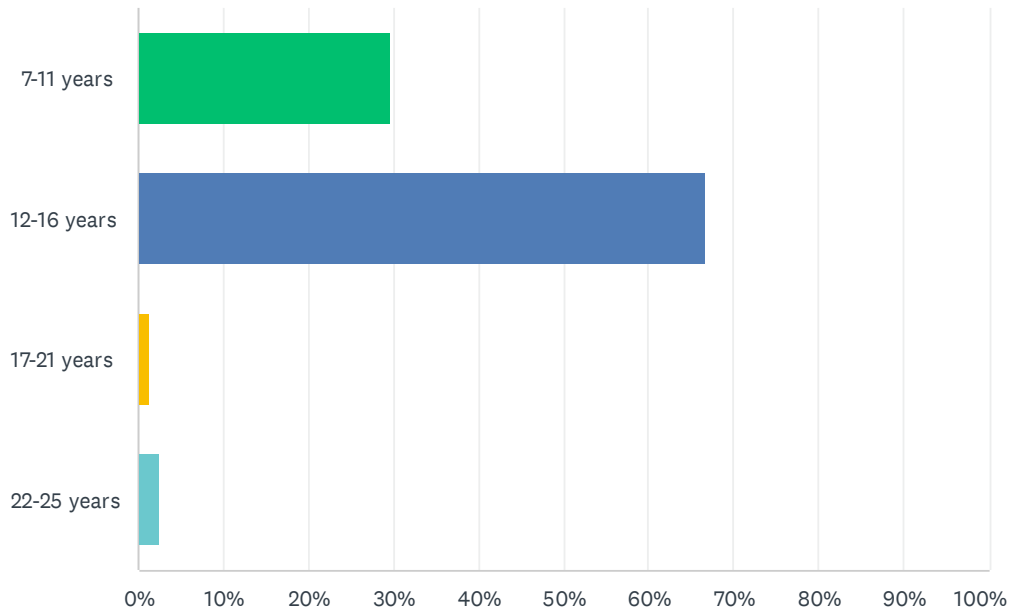

Q8 What is the age range of children/young people most in need of more facilities?

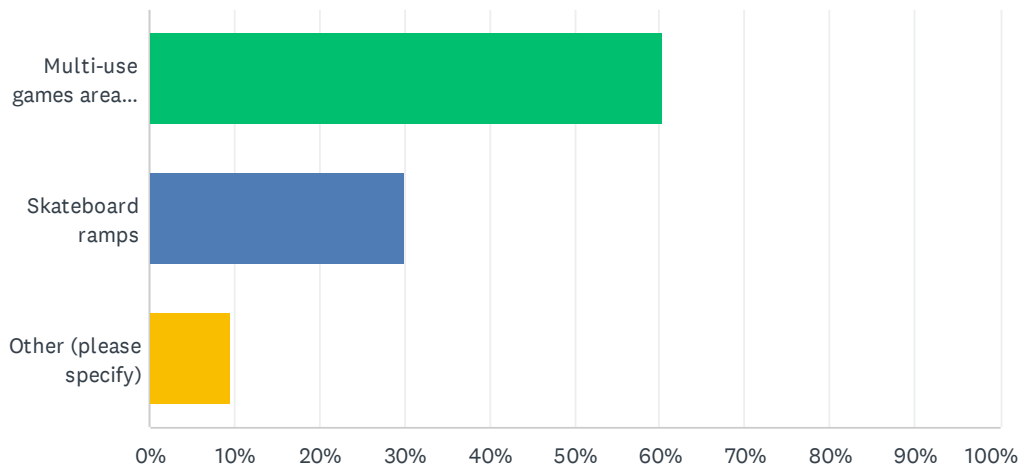

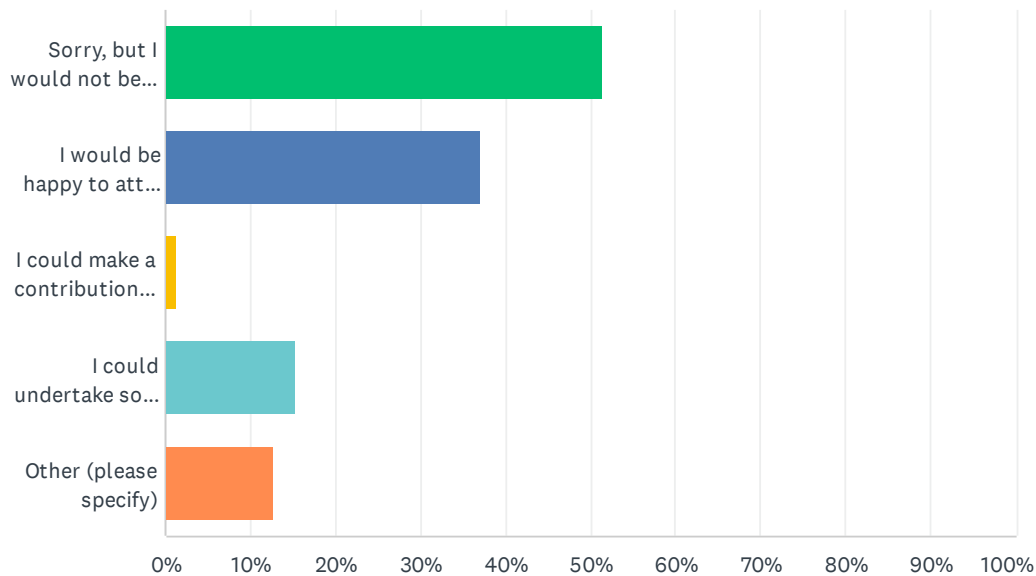

1	Sports facilities are beyond the means of the Parish Council and, indeed, should be within the purview of Cornwall Council. Access to good sports facilities is a problem in rural areas where public transport links are limited. That said Tregony hosts excellent facilities at the Roseland Academy; I am unclear as to what access local residents have to this excellent facility – my understanding is that it is closely managed by the Roseland Academy, but I am unsighted as to what provisions are in place for public use (given that the Academy is publically funded plus how the facility was originally funded may also have a bearing). I have heard that the hall can be rented out to local clubs although the rates are such that few can now afford to do so. I suspect that these factors would mitigate against any substantial public investment in Tregony. Nonetheless, an examination of how the facilities at Roseland Academy might be better used might be worthwhile. how the facilities at Roseland Academy might be better used might be worthwhile. Obviously there are many local children that go to the Academy and, therefore, may already benefit. This probably reduces the issue to small projects. I am unsighted as to what facilities already exist and, therefore, what might be feasible. My view is that this is a subject that merits detailed consideration including an assessment of need (by age groups?) and possible sources of funding (Cornwall Council, Lottery, Wind Turbine funds, Parish Council reserves) following which aspiration can be matched to reality and, so, unlikely to be resolved by the November meeting	10/16/2021 11:00 AM

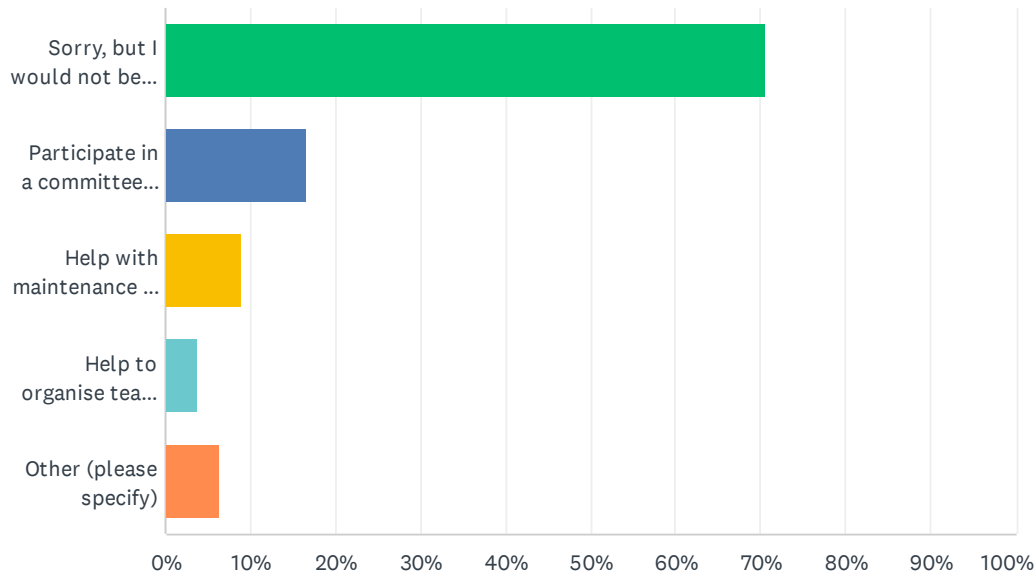

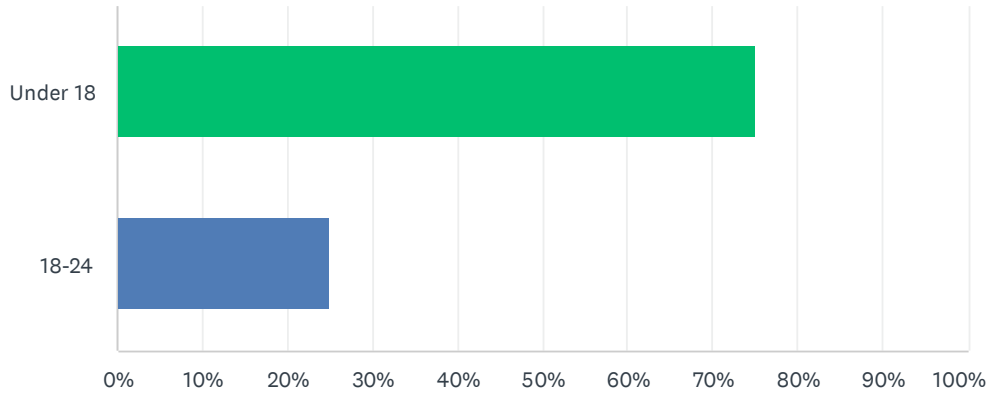
