

**MINUTES OF TREGONY WITH CUBY PARISH COUNCIL CEMETERY
COMMITTEE MEETING ON MONDAY, 27th SEPTEMBER 2021**

Action

- 7/21C **PRESENT** were Cllrs Matthews (Chair), Floyd Norris and Lytham
Clerk – Mrs M Symons
- 8/21C **APOLOGIES** - none
- 9/21C **THE MINUTES** of the meeting held on 1st July 2021 had been circulated previously.
Resolved that the minutes were adopted as a true record- proposed Cllr Floyd-Norris, seconded
Cllr Lytham.
- MATTERS ARISING** from Inspection of Cemeteries
- 10/21C 1. Grave 183 – Mrs FM Grose and Edward Grose – the family have seen holes around
the grave and also found problems with the grave top where the gravel sits. Cllr
Matthews has been and inspected for mice and laid poison. There doesn't seem to be a
problem now following inspection. Family now given the OK to start repair on the
grave.
- 11/21C 2. Ivy had overgrown the side fence but had fallen over and needed clearing – Chris
Davidson has removed
- 12/21C 3. Gate – Cllrs noticed that the gate seems to be always left open – Clerk will get a notice
to put on gate.
- MATTERS ARISING** from minutes
- 13/21C 1. The Committee has been official formed and given it terms of reference and financial
responsibilities. Councillors are happy to work as instructed.
- 14/21C 2. Roadside wall of Old Cemetery – general contractor has been asked to spray off
weeds.
- 15/21C **HOCKINGS MEADOW** – quotes are being sought for the draining of the top gateway of field
and fencing along right-hand side boundary. Approaching 3-4 local contractors.
- 16/21C **SINKING GRAVES** - Dave Dingle is happy to help fill-in/ level the sinking graves.
- 17/21C **CREMATION AREA** – Since the wall restoration in the last few years, it has been agreed that
memorials should no longer be placed directly on the wall. Rather the memorial should stand
off the wall about 1 foot and have a small plinth in front – slate 12” x 12”
It will be allowed to continue around the other side of the gate when full over the other side.
- 18/21C **SETTING OUT OF GRAVES & FUTURE PROVISION** – David Dingle will liaise with
Mary to work out the numbers of graves remaining in present site.
We need new markers for the site – unable to purchase / replace the metal markers Some
thought needed – perhaps local craftsman / woodworker could make?
- 19/21C **MEETING DATES**
Agreed that the previous 3-4 meetings a year would be good. Agreed March / June / September
and if necessary December. Last Monday of the month? TBA
- 20/21C **CORRESPONDENCE**
